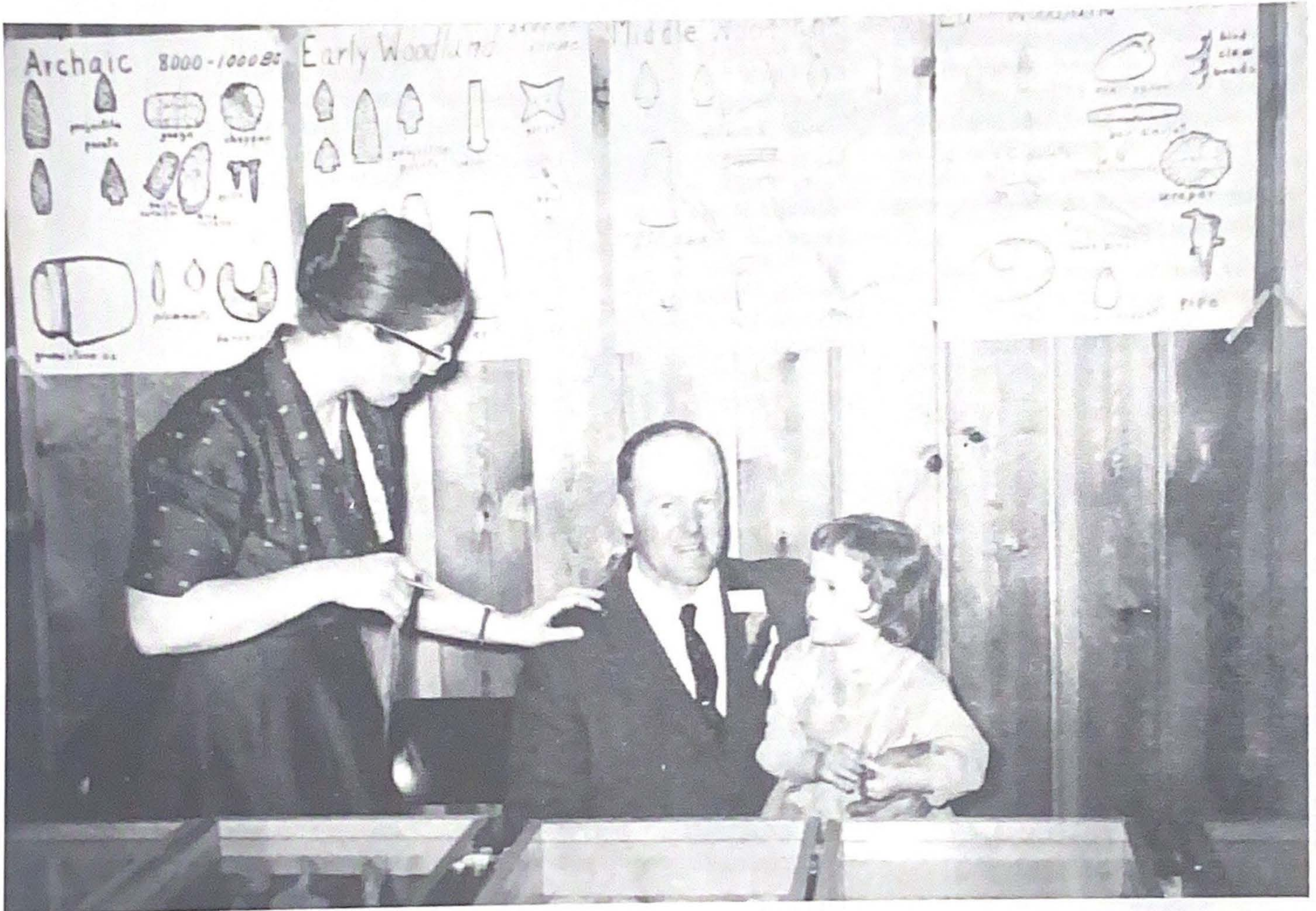

WHAT TO DO WHEN THE POWER IS OFF

1. Check your fuses and switches below meter. If some of your lights work, then the trouble is in your own fuses. Remember to check the main cartridge fuses in the fuse box.
2. If all the lights are off, then check with your neighbor to see if his power is off.
3. If you have not found the trouble, call the appropriate number listed below. Be sure to give your name, location and map number which is to the right of your name on the address side of the billing card. This map number is used the same as a street address in locating your place. Please call in as soon as the trouble is discovered or anything wrong with the line is noticed.

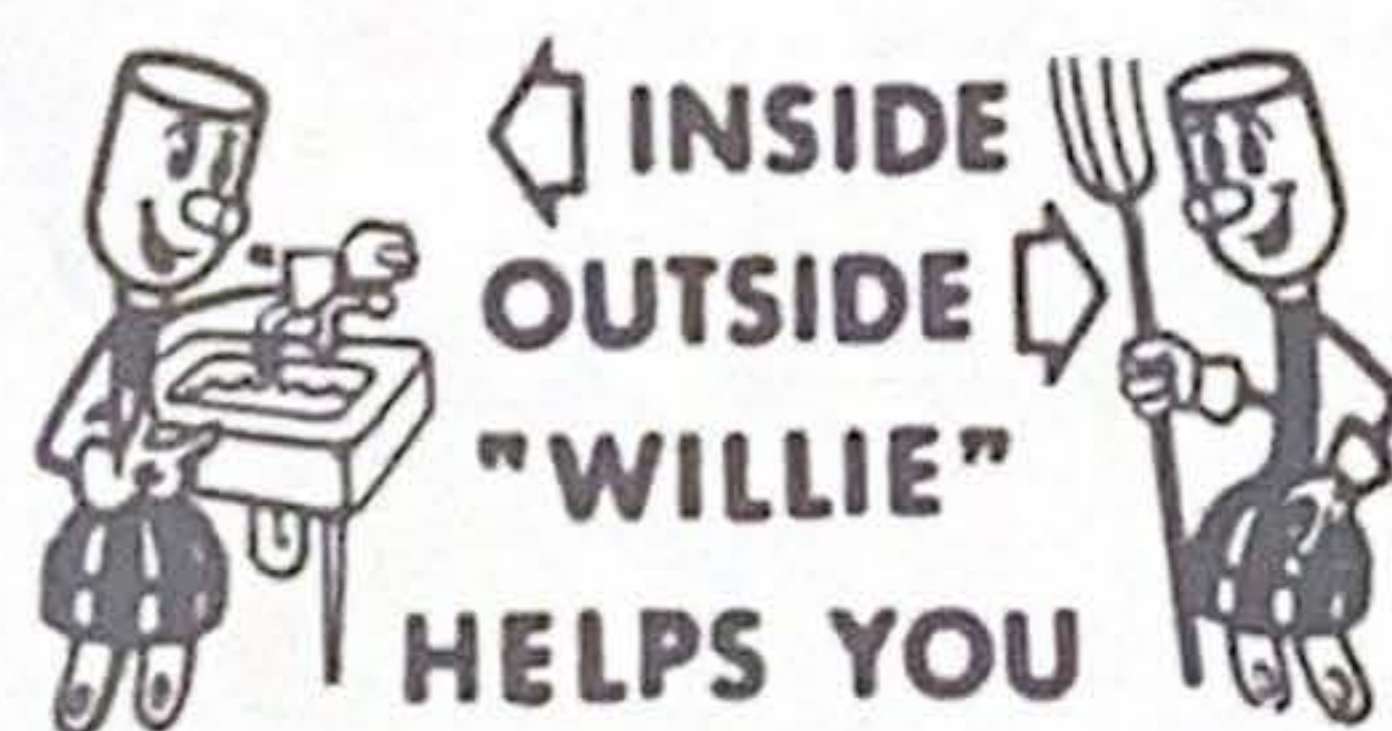

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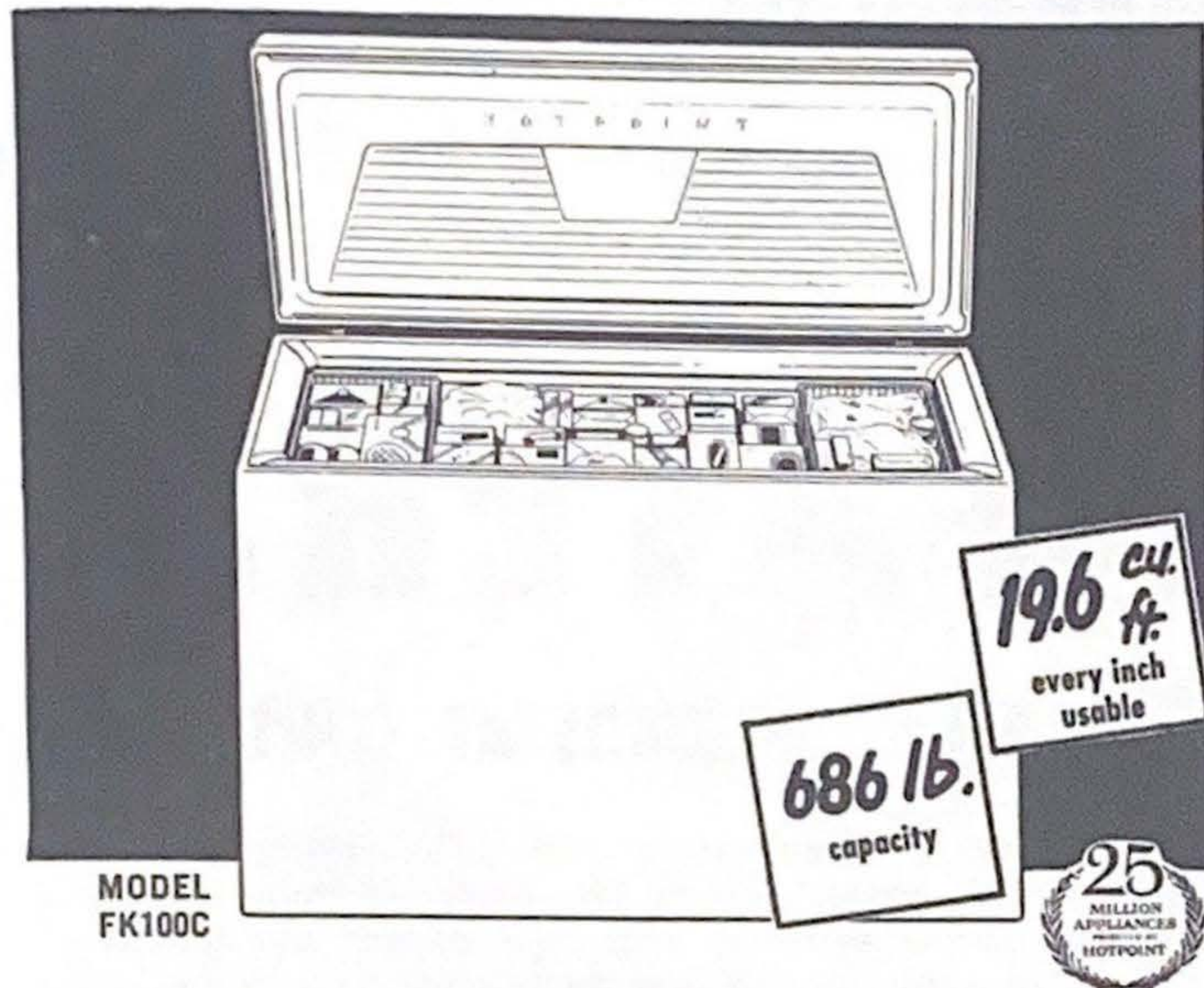

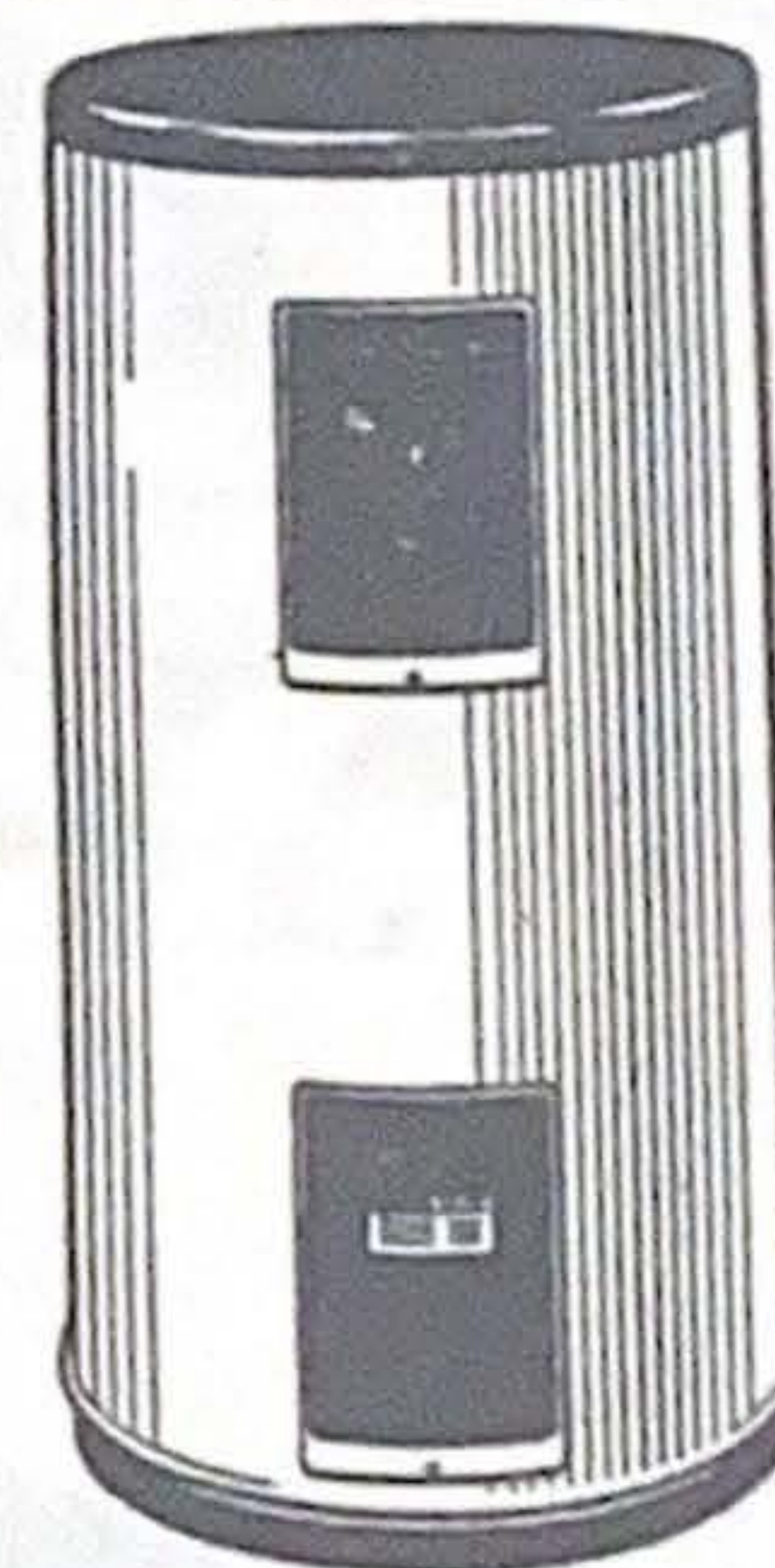

The Siloam Springs Earth Science Club is a state chartered organization formed for the study, collection and to create interest in Geology, Mineralogy, Paleontology, Chonchology, Archaeology, and Gemology. It was formed several years ago by several persons who were interested in these things and who are commonly known as "Rock Hounds." Among the founders of the organization were the Ellis Reichs of Mt. Sterling — Mr. Reich served as first president of the club; Bill Roberts, who conducts a barber shop on main street Mt. Sterling; Robert Erickson, former manager of the Prairie Farms Creamery in Mt. Sterling; the Bernard Hoelschers, who have a nice collection and former Brown County farm adviser, Arthur Haas and his wife.

Recently the club made and donated a case filled with rocks, minerals and gems to the Brown County High School. A show is annually given each year in Mt. Sterling and a joint show with the Springfield club is an annual event each spring in New Berlin, Ill. This is said to be one of the best rock shows in the state. The date for this show this year is April 27 and 28, 1963.

The club is a member of the Midwest Federation and affords a outlet for the pursuit of a fast growing hobby. Other officers recently elected in the club are: Sam Heaton of Mt. Sterling, Vice President; Mrs. Bernard Hoelscher of Mt. Sterling, Treasurer; and Mrs. Ellis Reich, Secretary and Liaison Officer.

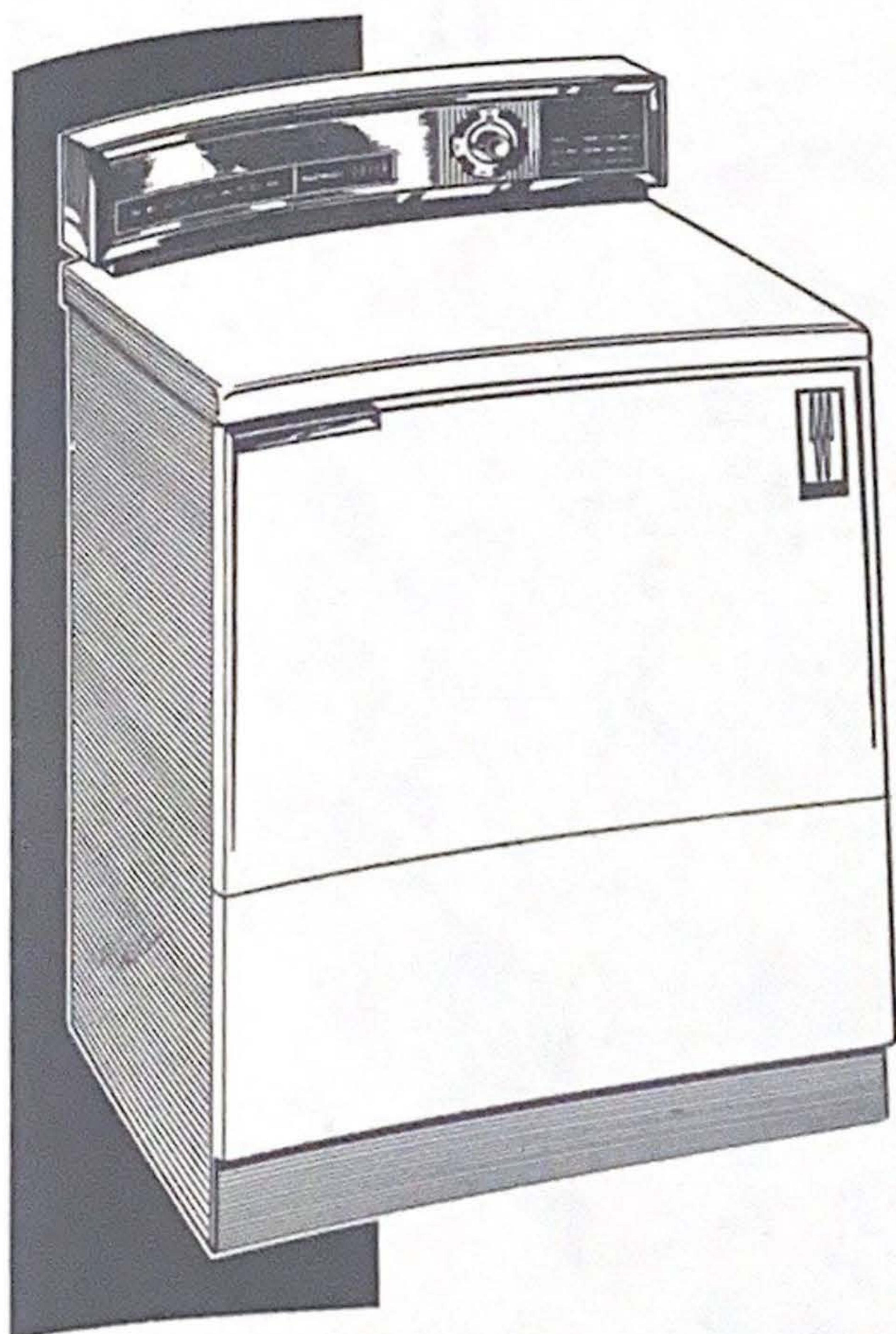

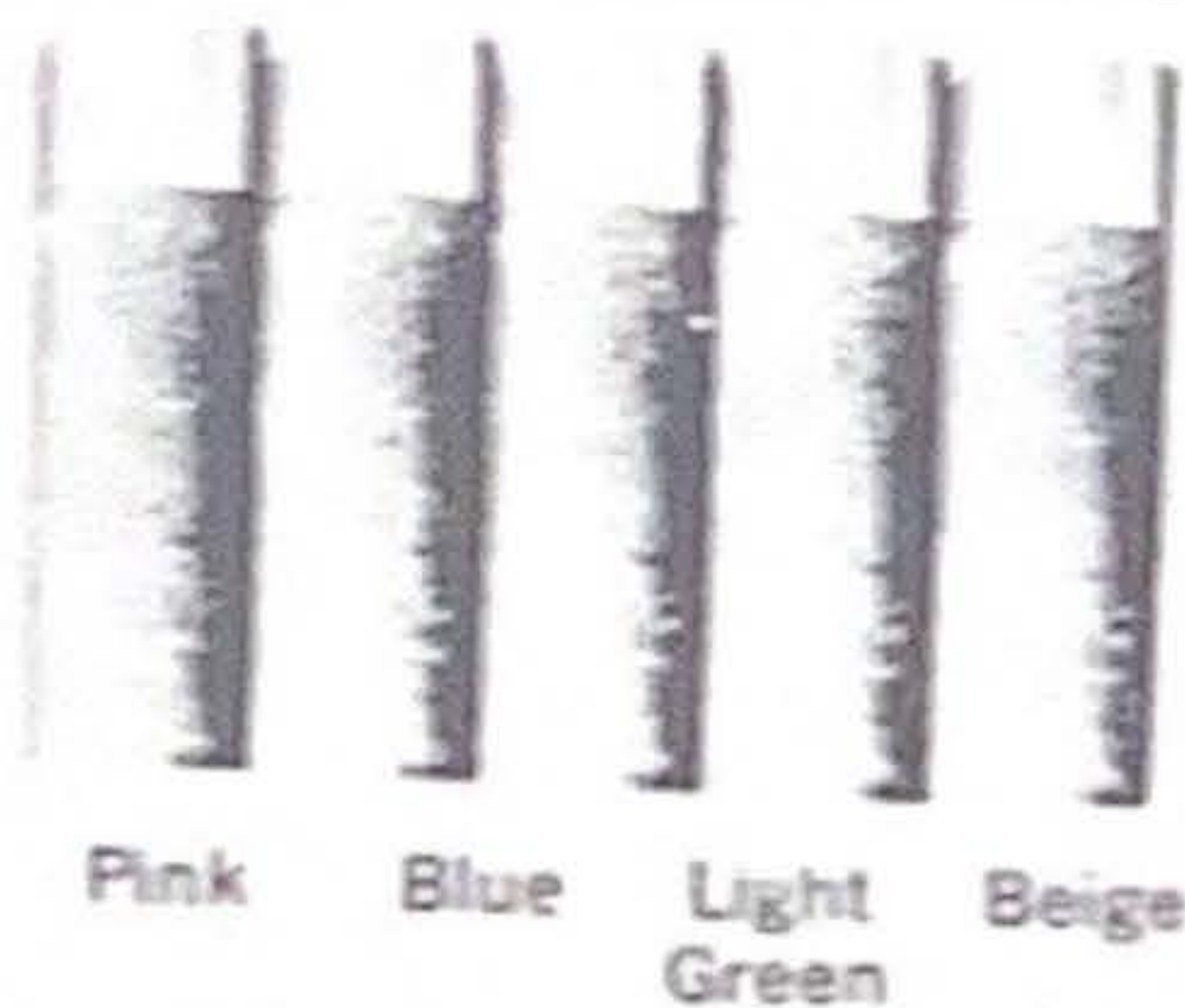
